The Council Shooting Sports Committee is committed to offering as many individuals as possible the tools and information they need to properly and safely operate a shooting sports program.

Archery is one of the featured Shooting Sports the council offers throughout the year and is often the first shooting sports many Scouts experience when they become a Scout. There are several new guidelines coming out from the BSA regarding Shooting Sports and these trainings are also designed to give you knowledge of these new guidelines in order to operate within the rules and regulations of the BSA.

Level 1 teaches the student how to instruct beginning archers and Level 2 teaches how to instruct intermediate archers. Unique to Archery, course participants for Level 1 can be youth, but **MUST** be at least 15 years of age to participate in this course. The maximum participation for this course is 12 individuals.

The cost for this training is \$30.00 (Level 1) \$50.00 (Level 1 & 2); included in the cost is all the training materials and lunch on the training date.
