3/1/21 Formational presentation by Mr. Kragness at Troop meeting. Work on Merit Badge Choices and Older Scout (Tier 1 and 2) Adventure Choices.

3/8/21 Detailed email sent to Troop with all Many Point related attachments. Sign Up Genius sent out to Troop Families.

3/29/21 Older Scout Adventure (Tier 1 and 2) choices to Mr Kragness. Tier 1 is additional adventures for Scouts entering the 8th grade. Tier 2 is additional adventures for Scouts entering 9th grade and older.

4/10/21 Sign Up Genius Deadline – If you are going to Camp you must commit by this date.

4/15/21 \$25 Deposit per camper deducted from Scout Account. Mr. Kragness sends in Troop attendees registration information.

6/1/21 Balance of Camp Fees Deducted from Scout Account (see fees section below for details)

6/30/21 All Scouts must have an up to date physical on file with the Troop Health & Safety Officer

7/29/21 PREPACK Night @TBD - 6:30pm

8/1/21 7am: arrive at Akin Road Elementary School (ARES) to leave for Camp. Stop in Park Rapids for Lunch on trip up

8/1/21 to 8/7/21 IN CAMP (Sunday -Saturday)

8/7/21 2:30pm Arrive back at ARES. Stop in St Cloud for lunch on the way home.

Steps to Complete prior to CAMP.....

STEP #1 - Register Scout and Adult on Troop Sign-Up Genius for Camp.

STEP#2 – Review the Merit Badge List and let Mr. Kragness know your choices.

STEP#3 – Make sure your Scouts account has a positive balance to cover all Camp fees . Or make arrangements with the Troop Treasurer for payment.

STEP#4- Make sure your Scout has an up to date health form on file. Adults going to camp must also have a current health form. All parts of the form are to be completed.

STEP#5 – Mark your calendars for PREPACK Night – Thursday, July 29rd 6:30pm @TBD
